Guild Group, (Port Colborne, Ontario) History for Niagara Archives

Port Colbornes Guild group had its first meeting on October 29, 1956 with original members John R., Rufus F., Cliff W., and others as substantiated by GSO. The Guild group was a branch-off from a group called The Port Colborne Group, and in the early days, fell under the Buffalo General Service District.
